Eligibility

Eligible applicants include Maple Ridge and Pitt Meadows nonprofit organizations, which support the Arts, Culture and/or the Environment. Applicants must demonstrate fiscal responsibility and effective management.

What We Fund

The Wine Festival Committee supports a wide range of projects that will be of benefit to the citizens of Maple Ridge and Pitt Meadows. Funded activities often provide a direct service to the community, or take an innovative approach to a community concern. The WFC is responsive to changing community needs and issues.

Ineligible Requests

- 100% of project costs
- Retroactive funding, or for any project expenses to be incurred prior to the WFC decision date
- Activities of religious organizations
- Towards operating or capital deficits

Application Deadline

There is an annual deadline for receiving grant applications, which is June 9th, 2010 this year.

Written applications will be accepted until 4:00pm on the closing date.

The WFC requires approximately four to six weeks processing an application.
